Additional declarations on the phytosanitary certificate according to Article 71 (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament of the Council of 26 October 2016 on protective measures against pests of plants except wood and wood packing material - without usszeile to prohibition of imports -

The phytosanitary certificate shall specify under the heading 'Additional Declaration' which specific requirement is fulfilled, whenever allows for several different options for such requirements.

That specification shall include the full wording of the relevant requirement!
